ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN CHAI WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 10 May 2019, the following road sections in Chai Wan will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of On Yip Street from a point about 20 metres west of its junction with Sun Yip Street to the same junction;
- (b) the section of Sun Yip Street from a point about 20 metres south of its junction with On Yip Street to the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Sun Yip Street from its junction with On Yip Street to a point about 15 metres north of the same junction;
- (d) the eastern kerbside lane of Sun Yip Street from a point about 25 metres north of its junction with On Yip Street to the same junction;
- (e) the northern kerbside lane of Siu Sai Wan Road from its junction with Sun Yip Street to a point about 35 metres east of the same junction; and
- (f) the southern kerbside lane of Siu Sai Wan Road from a point about 20 metres east of its junction with Sun Yip Street to the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections and the eastern kerbside lane of Sun Yip Street from a point of about 20 metres south of its junction with On Yip Street to a point about 30 metres south of the same junction will be rescinded.
