ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON WO MUK ROAD AND LUEN CHIT STREET, FANLING

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 11 May 2019, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones from 7.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight daily:—

- (a) the section of northern kerbside lane of Wo Muk Road from a point about 15 metres west of its junction with Luen Chit Street to a point about 30 metres east of the same junction; and
- (b) the section of eastern and western kerbside lanes of Luen Chit Street from its junction with Wo Muk Road to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones from 7.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. daily on the above road section will be rescinded.
