ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONE ON WAN TSUI ROAD, CHAI WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.00 p.m. on 17 June 2019 to 6.00 p.m. on 17 September 2019, the western kerbside lane of Wan Tsui Road from a point about 150 metres south of its junction with Chai Wan Road to a point about 65 metres south of the same junction will continue to be temporarily designated as a restricted zone 24 hours daily.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

(a) picking up or setting down passengers; or

(b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zone has been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
