

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES ON KING FUNG PATH, TUEN MUN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 14 June 2019 to 15 August 2019, the following road sections on King Fung Path will be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of King Fung Path from a point about 45 metres east of its junction with Castle Peak Road—San Hui to a point about 150 metres east of the same junction; and
- (b) the western kerbside lane of King Fung Path from a point about 65 metres east of its junction with Castle Peak Road—San Hui to a point about 150 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) Loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
