

## PUBLIC HEALTH AND MUNICIPAL SERVICES ORDINANCE (Chapter 132)

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE AN ORDER TO DIRECT REMOVAL  
AND DISPOSAL OF HUMAN REMAINS FROM  
WO HOP SHEK CEMETERY, SANDY RIDGE CEMETERY,  
SANDY RIDGE URN CEMETERY, CHEUNG CHAU CEMETERY,  
TAI O CEMETERY AND LAI CHI YUEN CEMETERY

It is hereby notified that the Director of Food and Environmental Hygiene intends to make an order under section 119A of the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Chapter 132) at the expiration of 1 month from the date of publication of this notice to direct that the human remains buried in the following sections of the specified cemeteries during the specified year shall be removed:—

Those persons having a proper interest in the disposal of the human remains referred to above should apply to the Director of Food and Environmental Hygiene to arrange removal of the remains by private exhumation on or before 30 August 2019. In the absence of such arrangement by the concerned parties, the remains shall be cremated at a Government crematorium and the ashes buried at the Sandy Ridge Urn Cemetery or such other cemetery as the Director of Food and Environmental Hygiene may decide.

Any person who wishes to arrange for the private exhumation and disposal of any of the human remains referred to above should apply to the Director of Food and Environmental Hygiene at the Cemeteries and Crematoria Office situated at Upper Ground Floor, 6 Cheong Hang Road, Hung Hom, Kowloon on or before 30 August 2019.

Any person who wishes to find out if the human remains of their deceased relatives will be involved in the intended removal, may also contact the Health Inspector (Cemeteries and Crematoria) on 2675 6944.
