

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONE ON TUNG TAU TSUEN ROAD, WONG TAI SIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 21 June 2019, the following road sections on Tung Tau Tsuen Road will be designated restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Tung Tau Tsuen Road from a point about 55 metres east of its junction with Junction Road to a point about 90 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Tung Tau Tsuen Road from a point about 55 metres east of its junction with Junction Road to a point about 85 metres east of the same junction; and
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Tung Tau Tsuen Road from a point about 115 metres east of its junction with Junction Road to a point about 150 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zone will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zone on the above road section will be temporarily rescinded.
