ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES ON WAN TSUI ROAD, CHAI WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 p.m. on 21 June 2019 to 6.00 p.m. on 28 June 2019, the following road sections will be temporarily designated as a restricted zone 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Chai Wan Road from its junction with Sui Man Road to a point about 70 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Wan Tsui Road from its junction with Fei Tsui Road to a point about 40 metres north of the same junction; and
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Wan Tsui Road from a point about 65 metres south of its junction with Chai Wan Road to a point about 255 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
