TELECOMMUNICATIONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 106)

Pursuant to section 7C(4) of the Telecommunications Ordinance, the Communications Authority ('CA') hereby gives notice on its proposal to vary the Class Licence for Medical Implant Communication System Device ('Class Licence') to expand its scope to cover:—

- (a) the possession and use of Medical Implant Communication System ('MICS') devices operating within the 401–402 MHz and/or 405–406 MHz bands, in addition to MICS devices operating within the 402–405 MHz band which are covered in the current version of the Class Licence; and
- (b) trading activities in respect of all MICS devices operating in the 401–406 MHz band.
