

PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 138)

DIRECTION MADE BY THE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE
OF THE PHARMACY AND POISONS BOARD OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that a Disciplinary Committee appointed by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong under section 15 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, Chapter 138, Laws of Hong Kong to inquire into the conduct of an authorized seller of poisons, namely Cheung Wah Dispensary Ltd., at Ground Floor 113 Ma Tau Wai Road, To Kwa Wan, Kowloon, has conducted an inquiry on 23 May 2019 in accordance with section 16 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance.

The said Committee was satisfied after the inquiry that Cheung Wah Dispensary Ltd. had been guilty of misconduct in that at the material time, Cheung Wah Dispensary Ltd., an authorized seller of poisons, and its employee, Mr LAI Man-chung, were convicted of the following offences under the Trade Descriptions Ordinance, Chapter 362, Laws of Hong Kong, and the Pharmacy and Poisons Regulations, Chapter 138A, Laws of Hong Kong on 30 August 2018 at the Kowloon City Magistrates' Courts for which the following orders were imposed:—

It is further notified that under section 16(2)(b) of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, the said Committee directed that the Secretary of the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong serve a warning letter on Cheung Wah Dispensary Ltd. The said Committee added that its direction should be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette with an account of the proceedings.
