## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

## RESTRICTED ZONES ON CHOI HING ROAD, KWUN TONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 5 July 2019, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Choi Hing Road from a point about 15 metres east of its junction with Choi Hing Lane to the eastern end of Choi Hing Road;
- (b) the unnamed roads connecting with the aforesaid section of Choi Hing Road; and
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of Choi Hing Road from a point about 12 metres east of its junction with Choi Hing Lane to the eastern end of Choi Hing Road.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, are prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zone will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zone on the above road sections as gazetted under G.N. 5510 on 27 August 2010 will be rescinded.
