PWP ITEM NO. 6720TH WIDENING OF TOLO HIGHWAY/FANLING HIGHWAY BETWEEN ISLAND HOUSE INTERCHANGE AND FANLING—STAGE 2

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has ordered under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance') to close temporarily sections of the existing at-grade carriageways, footpaths, access tracks, cycle tracks, footbridges, pedestrian and cycle bridge, and vehicular bridges within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. HyD/TFH/GZ/009 to HyD/TFH/GZ/012 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, and as amended by Amendment Plans Nos. HvD/TFH/GZ/009A to HvD/TFH/GZ/012A ('the Amendment Plans') and described in the amendment scheme annexed thereto, and as modified by Modification Plan No. HvD/TFH/GZ/011B ('the Modification Plan'). The Plans and scheme were referred to in G.N. 4060 published on 3 July 2009 and 10 July 2009. The Amendment Plans and amendment scheme were referred to in G.N. 3004 published on 28 May 2010 and 4 June 2010. The Modification Plan was referred to in G.N. 4890 published on 29 July 2011 and 5 August 2011. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that from 20 July 2019 to 19 July 2020, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing at-grade carriageways, footpaths, access tracks, cycle tracks, footbridges, pedestrian and cycle bridge, and vehicular bridges to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period.

The works to be carried out in association with this closure mainly involve the widening of Fanling Highway between Tai Hang and Wo Hop Shek Interchange from dual three-lane carriageway to dual four-lane carriageway, realignment of a section of Tai Wo Service Road West and Tai Wo Service Road East, installation of noise barriers, and other ancillary works.
