

It is hereby notified that sealed tenders in duplicate are invited for **Contract No. HY/2019/01, Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge Hong Kong Boundary Crossing Facilities—Phase 2 and Other Works (Public Works Programme Item No. 845TH)**. The contract includes the remaining and improvement works at the Hong Kong Port which comprises vehicle clearance kiosks for private cars and associated road works at the vehicle clearance plazas; provision of additional pick-up bays for cross boundary coaches, cross boundary shuttles and franchised buses at the north and south public transport interchanges; a public toilet; a refuse collection point; improvement works at the Passenger Clearance Building; landscaping and associated works; and installation of specialized equipment, etc. The contract is scheduled to commence in December 2019 for completion in December 2021.

Tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board and placed in the Government Secretariat Tender Box located at the lobby of the Public Entrance on the Ground Floor, East Wing, Central Government Office, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong, before 12.00 noon on Friday, 23 August 2019. Tenders must be deposited in the tender box as specified in this tender notice ("Specified Tender Box") before the tender closing time. Late tenders and tenders not deposited in the Specified Tender Box will not be accepted. If a black rainstorm warning signal or tropical cyclone signal No. 8 or above is in effect at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Friday, 23 August 2019, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12.00 noon on the first working day after the black rainstorm warning signal has ceased to be in effect or the tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 is lowered. In case of blockage of the public access to the location of the Specified Tender Box at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Friday, 23 August 2019, the Government will announce extension of the tender closing time until further notice. Following removal of the blockage, the Government will announce the extended tender closing time as soon as practicable. Contractors on the Lists of Approved Contractors for Public Works in Group C (confirmed) under the Buildings or Roads and Drainage Category or joint ventures with participation of local and/or overseas contractors with the lead participant or the major shareholder being on the Lists of Approved Contractors for Public Works in Group C (confirmed) under the Buildings or Roads and Drainage Category who also meet the following qualification and other conditions for participation stipulated in the tender documents are invited to tender:—

Having completed at least one building contract or civil engineering contract relating to the construction of buildings works or road and drainage works for the Immigration Control Points of Hong Kong, with the awarded contract sum of not less than HK\$300 million for each contract, within the past 15 years counting from but exclusive of the original date set for the close of tender.
