ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN HEUNG CHE STREET, TSUEN WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 19 July 2019, the following road sections in Tsuen Wan will be designated restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Heung Che Street from a point about 75 metres north of its junction with Hoi Pa Street to a point about 35 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Heung Che Street from its junction with Hoi Pa Street to a point about 10 metres south of the same junction; and
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Heung Che Street from a point about 55 metres north of its junction with Hoi Pa Street to a point about 40 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones above, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road section will be rescinded.
