

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON HOW MING STREET AND WAI YIP STREET,
KWUN TONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 9.00 a.m. on 18 August 2019, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of How Ming Street from its junction with Wai Yip Street to a point about 12 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Wai Yip Street from its junction with How Ming Street to a point about 5 metres west of the same junction; and
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of Wai Yip Street from its junction with How Ming Street to a point about 15 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, are prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zone will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zone from 7.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. daily on the above road sections will be rescinded.
