## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

## EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN TO KWA WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 25 August 2019 to 15 September 2019, the following road sections in To Kwa Wan will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Chi Kiang Street from its junction with Ma Tau Wai Road (northbound) to a point about 15 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Chi Kiang Street from its junction with Ma Tai Wai Road (northbound) to a point about 10 metres west of the same junction; and
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Ma Tau Wai Road (northbound) from its junction with Kiang Hsi Street to a point about 75 metres north of its junction with Kiang Su Street.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones has been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
