

It is hereby notified that sealed tenders in triplicate are invited for **Contract No. 2061EM19T—Triennial Term Contract for the Comprehensive Maintenance and Repair of Escalator Installations at Various Premises of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (Package Two of OT19)**. The scope of the Works includes comprehensive maintenance and repair of escalator installations at various premises of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region. The Contract is scheduled to commence in February 2020 for expiry in January 2023.

Sealed tenders in triplicate must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the Chairman, Public Works Tender Board and placed in the Public Works Tender Box situated in Room 4128f on the 41st Floor, Queensway Government Offices, 66 Queensway, Hong Kong, before 12.00 noon on Friday, 4 October 2019. Tenders must be deposited in the tender box as specified in this tender notice ("Specified Tender Box") before the tender closing time. Late tenders and tenders not deposited in the Specified Tender Box will not be accepted.

If a black rainstorm warning signal or tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 or above is in force at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Friday, 4 October 2019, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12.00 noon on the first working day after the black rainstorm warning signal has ceased to be in effect or the tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 is lowered. In case of blockage of the public access to the location of the Specified Tender Box at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon, on Friday, 4 October 2019, the Government will announce extension of the tender closing time until further notice. - (B) Contractor must have completed Escalator maintenance contracts in or outside Hong Kong within the past 5 years with the minimum accumulated awarded contract sum of not less than HK\$25 million.
