ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN SHAU KEI WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 30 August 2019, the following road sections in Shau Kei Wan will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Tung Hei Road eastbound from a point about 20 metres east of its junction with Oi Lai Street to a point about 105 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Tam Kung Temple Road from its western junction with Tung Hei Road to a point about 15 metres north of the same junction; and
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Tung Hei Road eastbound from a point about 40 metres east of its junction with Oi Lai Street to a point about 160 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
