ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN WAN CHAI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 31 August 2019 to 30 September 2020, the following road sections in Wan Chai will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Convention Avenue from a point about 45 metres west of its junction with Tonnochy Road to a point about 120 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Convention Avenue from its junction with Fleming Road to a point about 20 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Fleming Road from its junction with Convention Avenue to a point about 130 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Fleming Road from its junction with Lung Wo Road to a point about 140 metres south of the same junction;
- (e) the southern kerbside lane of Lung Wo Road from its junction with Fleming Road to a point about 30 metres west of the same junction;
- (f) the northern kerbside lane of Lung Wo Road from its junction with Expo Drive East to a point about 100 metres west of the same junction;
- (g) the western kerbside lane of Expo Drive East from its junction with Lung Wo Road to a point about 45 metres north of the same junction;
- (h) the southern kerbside lane of Expo Drive Central from its junction with Expo Drive East to a point about 25 metres west of the same junction; and
- (i) the eastern kerbside lane of Expo Drive East from its junction with Convention Avenue to a point about 70 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones has been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
