

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON WAI YIN PATH AND KO SHAN ROAD,
TO KWA WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 30 August 2019, the following road sections will be designated a restricted zone 24 hours daily.

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Wai Yin Path west of its junction with Ko Shan Road to a point about 10 metres west of the same junction.
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Ko Shan Road from a point about 55 metres north of its junction with Pak Kung Street to a point about 65 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
