TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has ordered under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance') to close temporarily sections of the existing carriageways, footways, verges, cycle tracks and central medians/traffic islands within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. NH 33005^C ('the Plan') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, and as modified by Modification Plans Nos. HNHADMINS-GZ0013 and HNHADMINS-GZ0014 ('the Modification Plans'), and as amended by Amendment Plans Nos. 60340456/GAZ/409 and 60340456/GAZ/410 ('the Amendment Plans') and described in the amendment scheme annexed thereto, and as further amended by Second Amendment Plans Nos. 60340456/GAZ/411 and 60340456/GAZ/412 ('the Second Amendment Plans') and described in the second amendment scheme annexed thereto. The Plan and scheme were referred to in G.N. 2456 published on 21 April 2006 and 28 April 2006. The Modification Plans were referred to in G.N. 1468 published on 2 March 2007 and 9 March 2007. The Amendment Plans and amendment scheme were referred to in G.N. 5612 published on 31 July 2015 and 7 August 2015. The Second Amendment Plans and second amendment scheme were referred to in G.N. 9723 published on 18 December 2015 and 24 December 2015. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that from 9 September 2019 to 8 September 2020, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing carriageways, footways, verges, cycle tracks and central medians/traffic islands to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period.

The works to be carried out in association with this closure mainly involve the improvement of an existing section of Sha Tau Kok Road near Lung Ma Road, widening of Lung Ma Road, construction of cycle track, footways and vertical noise barriers and other ancillary works.

A copy of the order, the Plan, the Modification Plans, the Amendment Plans and the Second Amendment Plans may be inspected by members of the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—

This notice will be affixed on or near the affected carriageways, footways, verges, cycle tracks and central medians/traffic islands on 6 September 2019.

Any person entitled to compensation under the Ordinance may serve upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing a written claim, which can be submitted *via* one of the following means, before the expiration of one year from the date of closure, extinction, modification or restriction:—

- (1) By post or by hand to the Transport and Housing Bureau's Drop-in Box No. 6 located at the 2nd Floor Entrance, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong. The box is available for use between 8.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. from Monday to Friday (except public holidays);
