ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

## TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES ON QUEEN'S ROAD WEST, WESTERN DISTRICT

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 9 September 2019 to 6.00 p.m. on 24 April 2020, the following road sections will be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) The southern kerbside lane of Queen's Road West from a point about 35 metres west of its junction with Hill Road to a point about 60 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) The northern kerbside lane of Queen's Road West between Hill Road and Whitty Street; and
- (c) The northern kerbside lane of Queen's Road West from its junction with Water Street to a point about 45 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be temporarily rescinded.
