

It is hereby notified that sealed tenders in triplicate are invited for **Contract No. 2023EM19T, 42-Month Term Contract for the Fault Attendance, Comprehensive Maintenance, Repair and Replacement of Special Lighting Systems at Various Premises of the Highways Department of the Government of HKSAR**. The scope of the Works includes the provision of fault attendance, preventive maintenance, corrective maintenance, repair and replacement services on special lighting works, such as subway, footbridge, walkway, ferry concourse and tram shelter lighting installations at various premises of the Highways Department of the Government of HKSAR. The Contract is scheduled to commence in February 2020 for expiry in July 2023.

Tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the Chairman, Public Works Tender Board, and placed in the Public Works Tender Box situated in Room 4128f, 41st Floor, Queensway Government Offices, 66 Queensway, Hong Kong before 12.00 noon on Friday, 22 November 2019. Tenders must be deposited in the tender box as specified in this tender notice ('Specified Tender Box') before the tender closing time. Late tenders and tenders not deposited in the Specified Tender Box will not be accepted.

If tropical cyclone signal No. 8 or above is hoisted, or a black rainstorm warning signal or 'extreme conditions after super typhoons' announced by the Government is/are in force at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Friday, 22 November 2019, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12.00 noon on the first working day after the tropical cyclone signal No. 8 is lowered, or the black rainstorm warning signal or the 'extreme conditions after super typhoons' announced by the Government has/have ceased to be in force. In case of blockage of the public access to the location of the Specified Tender Box at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon, on Friday, 22 November 2019, the Government will announce extension of the tender closing time until further notice. Following removal of the blockage, the Government will announce the extended tender closing time as soon as practicable.
