

It is hereby notified that sealed tenders in triplicate are invited for **Contract No. 1339EM18W—Replacement of the Traffic Control and Surveillance System (TCSS) in the Kai Tak Tunnel**. The scope of the Works includes dismantling and renovation of existing traffic control and surveillance facilities, and installation of new equipment. The new system will mainly consist of computer systems, communication facilities, variable message signs, and other traffic field equipment. The civil works include construction and erection of mounting structures for traffic field equipment, etc. The Contract is scheduled to commence in June 2020 for completion in June 2022.

Tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the Chairman, Public Works Tender Board and placed in the Public Works Tender Box situated in Room 4128f, 41st Floor, Queensway Government Offices, 66 Queensway, Hong Kong before 12.00 noon on Friday, 27 December, 2019. Tenders must be deposited in the tender box as specified in this tender notice ('Specified Tender Box') before the tender closing time. Late tenders or tenders not deposited in the Specified Tender Box will not be accepted.

If tropical cyclone signal No. 8 or above is hoisted, or a black rainstorm warning signal or 'extreme conditions after super typhoons' announced by the Government is/are in force at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Friday, 27 December 2019, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12.00 noon on the first working day after the tropical cyclone signal No. 8 is lowered, or the black rainstorm warning signal or the 'extreme conditions after super typhoons' announced by the Government has/have ceased to be in force. In case of blockage of the public access to the location of the Specified Tender Box at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Friday, 27 December 2019, the Government will announce extension of the tender closing time until further notice. Following removal of the blockage, the Government will announce the extended tender closing time as soon as practicable.
