ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON ON TIN STREET AND TAK TIN STREET, KWUN TONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 27 November 2019, the following sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of On Tin Street from its western junction with Ping Tin Street to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of On Tin Street from its western junction with Tak Tin Street to a point about 30 metres south of the same junction; and
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of Tak Tin Street from its western junction with On Tin Street to a point about 30 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above-mentioned road sections will be rescinded.
