ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON YAU SHIN STREET AND YAU CHUEN STREET, YUEN LONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 25 November 2019, the following road sections in Yuen Long will be designated as restricted zones from 7.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Yau Shin Street from its southern junction with Yau Chuen Street to a point about 70 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Yau Chuen Street from its southern junction with Yau Shin Street to a point about 20 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Yau Shin Street from its junction with the access road of Long Shin Estate to a point about 145 metres north of the same junction (except the Green Minibus layby); and
- (d) the section of the access road to Shin Leung House from its junction with Yau Shin Street and a point about 15 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
