TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, the Deputy Director/Specialist, Lands Department has made an order (hereinafter referred to as ‘the amendment order’) under section 15(1) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (hereinafter referred to as ‘the Ordinance’) directing that the rights of temporary occupation of land created by the order referred to in Government Notice No. 652 dated 9 February 2017 (hereinafter referred to as ‘the original order’) be amended to the effect that in relation to the land more particularly described in the first column below as shown coloured purple stippled black on the Plan No. HKM9830 annexed to the original order which land was described in the scheme referred to in Government Notice No. 9052 published on 27 November 2015 and 4 December 2015, the period during which rights of temporary occupation of land have been created shall be amended as described in the second column below:—

It is hereby declared that upon expiry of that period at midnight on 2 January 2020, the aforesaid amendment to the original order shall take effect. The effective date of the aforesaid amendment shall be 3 January 2020.

Personal Information Collection Statement
