Any person who considers that he has an interest, right or easement in or over such foreshore and sea-bed that will be injuriously affected by the undertaking may deliver a written claim for compensation for the injurious affection to the Director of Lands, 20th Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before the expiration of 1 year from the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette*, stating the sum of money which he is willing to accept in full and final settlement of his claim together with such particulars as he may possess to substantiate the claim.

SCHEDULE

Foreshore and sea-bed affected

Approximately 2 120 square metres of foreshore and sea-bed in Tseung Kwan O as delineated and shown edged red on a plan, numbered SKM9595, deposited in the Land Registry.

Description of the undertaking and the manner in which the foreshore and sea-bed will be affected by the proposed undertaking

- (i) Construction of a pair of permanent seawater intakes and a pair of permanent seawater outfalls along two sections of an existing seawall at Tseung Kwan O to support the seawater district cooling system in Tseung Kwan O Industrial Estate. The internal size of each intake/outfall will be about 2 metres wide by 2 metres high while the invert levels of the intakes and outfalls are about 3.5 metres and 2 metres below Hong Kong Principal Datum respectively.
- (ii) Reconstruction of the affected part of the above two sections of the seawall.

Personal Information Collection Statement
