

FORESHORE AND SEA-BED (RECLAMATIONS) ORDINANCE (Chapter 127)

(Notice of authorization under section 9)

PROPOSED PROTECTION WORKS FOR ASIA PACIFIC GATEWAY (APG)

It is hereby notified that the undertaking in relation to the foreshore and sea-bed described in the Schedule below as mentioned in G.N. 7143 published under section 5 on 22 and 29 November 2019 was authorized under section 7 on 20 February 2020.

Any person who considers that he has an interest, right or easement in or over such foreshore and sea-bed that will be injuriously affected by the undertaking may deliver a written claim for compensation for the injurious affection to the Director of Lands, 20th Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before the expiration of 1 year from the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette*, stating the sum of money which he is willing to accept in full and final settlement of his claim together with such particulars as he may possess to substantiate the claim.

SCHEDULE

Foreshore and sea-bed affected

Approximately 580 square metres of foreshore and sea-bed situated at Tseung Kwan O waters as delineated and shown by a bold red line on a plan, numbered SKM9624, deposited in the Land Registry.

Description of the undertaking and the manner in which the foreshore and sea-bed will be affected by the proposed undertaking

- (i) Installation of precast concrete mattress units with a width of approximately 6 metres along a section of approximately 100 metres of the Asia Pacific Gateway.
- (ii) Each of the unit will be lowered into position from a barge and will sink into the marine mud to a depth of around 1 metre (the sinking depth).
- (iii) In the event that the marine mud is particularly soft and the sinking depth is exceeded, the unit will be lifted off the sea-bed. A steel sea-bed bearing sheet will be installed on the sea-bed first and the unit will then be lowered on to the bearing sheet.
- (iv) The units will be connected together one by one by divers with short link steel chains.

Personal Information Collection Statement

Any information, including the personal data, submitted to the Director of Lands in connection with any written claims served under section 12(1) of the Foreshore and Sea-bed (Reclamations) Ordinance (Chapter 127) will be used for the processing of the claims and other related purposes. Persons who have so submitted their personal data have the rights to request access to and correction of their personal data held by us.
