

LANDS RESUMPTION ORDINANCE (Chapter 124)

RESUMPTION OF LAND FOR
NORTHEAST NEW TERRITORIES LANDFILL EXTENSION

To the owners and every person interested or having any right or easement in all those pieces or parcels of land in the New Territories more particularly described below and shown coloured orange on the Resumption Plan No. DNM2118k:—

TAKE NOTICE that the Chief Executive in Council has decided that the above-mentioned land is required for a public purpose, and under powers delegated by the Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, the Deputy Director/Specialist, Lands Department has made an order that the above-mentioned land shall be resumed and revert to the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region on the expiration of THREE MONTHS from the date of the affixing of this notice to the said land.
