ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON TUEN FU ROAD AND HING PING ROAD, TUEN MUN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 11 September 2020, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Tuen Fu Road from its junction with Hing Ping Road to a point about 7 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Tuen Fu Road from its junction with Hing Ping Road to a point about 7 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Hing Ping Road from its junction with Tuen Fu Road to a point about 23 metres east of the same junction; and
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Hing Ping Road from its junction with Tuen Fu Road to a point about 21 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
