ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN YUEN LONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 18 September 2020, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Yuen Lung Street from its junction with Fung Yau Street East to a point about 15 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Yuen Lung Street from its junction with Fung Yau Street East to a point about 30 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Fung Yau Street East from a point about 25 metres north of its junction with Yuen Lung Street to a point about 15 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Fung Yau Street East from a point about 25 metres north of its junction with Fung Kwan Street to a point about 30 metres south of the same junction;
- (e) the northern kerbside lane of Fung Kwan Street from its junction with Fung Yau Street East to a point about 85 metres west of the same junction;
- (f) the southern kerbside lane of Fung Kwan Street from its junction with Fung Yau Street East to a point about 65 metres west of the same junction; and
- (g) the section of the eastern access road of the northern public car park at Fung Kwan Street from its junction with Fung Kwan Street to a point about 10 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
