## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

## RESTRICTED ZONES IN HUNG SHUI KIU, YUEN LONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 18 September 2020, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Hung Shun Road from a point about 15 metres north of its junction with Ying Fuk Street to a point about 10 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Hung Shun Road from its junction with Ying Fuk Street to a point about 15 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Ying Fuk Street from its junction Hung Shun Road to a point about 35 metres west of the same junction; and
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Ying Fuk Street from a point about 15 metres west of its junction with Hung Shun Road to a point about 35 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs or road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
