ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN YUEN LONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 18 September 2020, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Sai Tai Street from its junction with Yuen Long Tai Cheung Street to a point about 20 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Yuen Long Tai Cheung Street from a point about 10 metres east of its junction with Sai Tai Street to a point about 30 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of Yuen Long Tai Cheung Street from a point about 10 metres east of its junction with Kuk Ting Street to a point about 25 metres east of the same junction;
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Kuk Ting Street between Yuen Long Tai Cheung Street and Shui Che Kwun Street; and
- (e) the eastern kerbside lane of Shui Che Kwan Street from its junction with Kuk Ting Street to a point about 10 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
