

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN
LUNG KING STREET, WAN CHAI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.00 p.m. on 30 September 2020 to 6.00 p.m. on 31 December 2020, the following road sections in Wan Chai will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Lung King Street from its junction with Fenwick Pier Street to a point about 90 metres north of the same junction; and
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Fenwick Pier Street from its junction with Lung King Street to a point about 45 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones has been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
