

It is hereby notified that sealed tenders in triplicate are invited for **Contract No. ED/2020/02, Development of Anderson Road Quarry Site—Infrastructure, Greening and Landscape Works (Public Works Programme Item Nos. 803CL & 818CL)**. The works mainly include:—

- (1) greening, landscape works and ancillary facilities of the open spaces, of around 15.5 hectares (ha), at the Development of Anderson Road Quarry (ARQ) site,
- (2) slope improvement works at the ARQ site,
- (3) formation of about 1 ha of land at the ARQ site and associated geotechnical works and road works, and
- (4) implementation of environmental mitigation measures and an environmental monitoring and audit programme for the above works.

The works are scheduled to commence in second half of 2021 for phased completion in 2023/24.

Sealed tenders, in triplicate, must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board and placed in the Government Secretariat Tender Box located at the lobby of the Public Entrance on the Ground Floor, East Wing, Central Government Office, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong, before 12.00 noon on Friday, 21 May 2021. Tenders must be deposited in the tender box as specified in this tender notice ('Specified Tender Box') before the tender closing time. Late tenders and tenders not deposited in the Specified Tender Box will not be accepted. If a black rainstorm warning signal or tropical cyclone signal No. 8 or above is in effect at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Friday, 21 May 2021, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12.00 noon on the first working day after the black rainstorm warning signal has ceased to be in effect or the tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 is lowered. In case of blockage of the public access to the location of the Specified Tender Box at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Friday, 21 May 2021, the Government will announce extension of the tender closing time until further notice. Following removal of the blockage, the Government will announce the extended tender closing time as soon as practicable. Contractors not yet on the List of Approved Contractors for Public Works in Group C under the Site Formation and/or Roads and Drainage Category may also submit a tender if they submit a request for participation together with a duly completed application for inclusion in the above-mentioned approved list/category by 23 April 2021 to Chief Engineer/E2, East Division 2, East Development Office, Civil Engineering Development Department, 8th Floor, Southern Tower, 11 Hoi Ting Road, Yau Ma Tei, Kowloon, Hong Kong, meet the qualifications and conditions for participation, and the application for inclusion is duly approved on or before the tender closing date.
