Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection proposes to execute the sewerage works within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 60566218/GAZ/400 to 408 (The 'Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plans and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

- (i) construction of about 5 800 metres of gravity sewers and associated manholes within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans;
- (ii) construction of about 2 600 metres of twin rising mains and associated manholes within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans; and
- (iii) ancillary works including reinstatement of carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, pedestrian crossings and amenity areas.
