

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN FA YUEN STREET AND SOY STREET, MONG KOK

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 13 April 2021, the following road sections in Mong Kok will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Fa Yuen Street from its junction with Soy Street to a point about 15 metres south of the same junction; and
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Soy Street from its junction with Sai Yee Street to a point about 15 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
