PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF DISEASE (COMPULSORY TESTING FOR CERTAIN PERSONS) REGULATION

Compulsory Testing Notice

I hereby exercise the power conferred on me by section 10(1) of the Prevention and Control of Disease (Compulsory Testing for Certain Persons) Regulation (*the Regulation*) (Chapter 599, sub. leg. J) to:—

Category of Persons

(I) specify the following category of persons:—

- (a) any person who is employed by the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, any statutory body or any company (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff) and has not completed a coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) vaccination course ^{INote 11}:---
 - (i) enters the airport restricted area as mentioned in section 35 of the Aviation Security Ordinance (Chapter 494) (*the Restricted Area*) for purpose(s) other than travelling by air to depart from or arrive at the Hong Kong International Airport; or
 - (ii) has his/her usual place of work at Terminal 1 of the Hong Kong International Airport, Chek Lap Kok, Lantau Island, New Territories, Hong Kong (*Terminal 1*);
- (b) any person who is employed by the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, any statutory body or any company (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff) and has completed a COVID-19 vaccination course [Note 1]:---
 - (i) enters the Restricted Area for purpose(s) other than travelling by air to depart from or arrive at the Hong Kong International Airport; or
 - (ii) has his/her usual place of work at Terminal 1;

Requirements and Procedure for the Test

- (II) require every person who falls within the above category specified in Part (I)(a) to undergo a polymerase chain reaction-based nucleic acid test for the coronavirus disease 2019 (*the Specified Test*) in compliance with the requirements and procedure set out below ^[Note 2]:—
 - (a) for a test at mobile specimen collection stations:-
 - (i) attend one of the mobile specimen collection stations ^[Note 3] set up by the Government and undergo the Specified Test, including providing a sample through a combined nasal and throat swab which must not be taken by the person himself/ herself, in accordance with the instructions given by the staff at the stations;
 - (ii) keep the SMS notification (mobile phone text message) containing the result of the test which must be issued within the past 7 days ^[Note 4] counting from the day when entering the Restricted Area or working at Terminal 1; and
 - (iii) provide the relevant SMS notification for checking by a prescribed officer when the prescribed officer requires the person to provide information about his or her undergoing the Specified Test;

<u>OR</u>

- (b) for a test at Community Testing Centres:-
 - (i) attend one of the Community Testing Centres [Note 5] set up by the Government during its opening hours and undergo the Specified Test, including providing a sample through a combined nasal and throat swab which must not be taken by the person himself/herself, in accordance with the instructions given by the staff at the centre;

- (ii) keep the SMS notification (mobile phone text message) containing the result of the test which must be issued within the past 7 days ^[Note 4] counting from the day when entering the Restricted Area or working at Terminal 1; and
- (iii) provide the relevant SMS notification for checking by a prescribed officer when the prescribed officer requires the person to provide information about his or her undergoing the Specified Test;

<u>OR</u>

- (c) for a self-arranged test:----
 - (i) arrange for the carrying out of the Specified Test at a laboratory which is included in a list of recognised laboratories for the Specified Test published at the coronavirus disease 2019 thematic website on https://www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/List_of_recognised_laboratories_RTPCR.pdf and which can issue SMS (mobile phone text message) notifications in respect of test results;
 - undergo the Specified Test in accordance with the instructions given by the staff of the laboratory and the sample through a combined nasal and throat swab must not be taken by the person himself/herself;
 - (iii) keep the SMS notification (mobile phone text message) containing the result of the test which must be issued within the past 7 days ^[Note 4] counting from the day when entering the Restricted Area or Terminal 1 for work; and
 - (iv) provide the relevant SMS notification for checking by a prescribed officer when the prescribed officer requires the person to provide information about his or her undergoing the Specified Test;

<u>OR</u>

- (d) for a test with a specimen bottle obtained (only applicable to persons who have received the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine [Note 6]):—
 - (i) obtain a specimen bottle from one of the 121 post offices, 47 general out-patient clinics of the Hospital Authority or vending machines set up at 20 MTR stations [Note 7];
 - (ii) collect deep throat saliva sample in the specimen bottle as per the guidelines provided together with the specimen bottle and return the specimen bottle with the sample to one of the designated collection points ^[Note 7];
 - (iii) keep the SMS notification (mobile phone text message) containing the result of the test which must be issued within the past 7 days ^[Note 4] counting from the day when entering the Restricted Area or working at Terminal 1; and
 - (iv) provide the relevant SMS notification for checking by a prescribed officer when the prescribed officer requires the person to provide information about his or her undergoing the Specified Test;

<u>OR</u>

- (e) for a test using a specimen bottle distributed to the places mentioned in Part (I) above by the Department of Health (if applicable) (only applicable to persons who have received the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine ^[Note 6]):—
 - (i) obtain a specimen bottle from the places mentioned in Part (I) above;
 - (ii) collect relevant sample in the aforesaid specimen bottle as per the guidelines in the specimen collection pack and return the specimen bottle with the sample to one of the designated collection points ^[Note 7];
 - (iii) keep the SMS notification (mobile phone text message) containing the result of the test which must be issued within the past 7 days [Note 4] counting from the day when entering the Restricted Area or working at Terminal 1; and
 - (iv) provide the relevant SMS notification for checking by a prescribed officer when the prescribed officer requires the person to provide information about his or her undergoing the Specified Test;

- (f) for a test at general out-patient clinics of the Hospital Authority (only applicable to persons who have received the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine [Note 6]):----
 - (i) undergo the Specified Test at general out-patient clinics of the Hospital Authority as instructed by a medical professional of the Hospital Authority;
 - (ii) keep the SMS notification (mobile phone text message) containing the result of the test which must be issued within the past 7 days ^[Note 4] counting from the day when entering the Restricted Area or working at Terminal 1; and
 - (iii) provide the relevant SMS notification for checking by a prescribed officer when the prescribed officer requires the person to provide information about his or her undergoing the Specified Test;
- (III) require every person who falls within the above category specified in Part (I)(b) to undergo the Specified Test in compliance with the requirements and procedure set out below ^[Note 2]:—
 - (a) for a test at mobile specimen collection stations:-
 - (i) attend one of the mobile specimen collection stations [Note 3] set up by the Government and undergo the Specified Test, including providing a sample, in accordance with the instructions given by the staff at the stations;
 - (ii) keep the SMS notification (mobile phone text message) containing the result of the test which must be issued within the past 14 days [Note 4] counting from the day when entering the Restricted Area or working at Terminal 1; and
 - (iii) provide the relevant SMS notification for checking by a prescribed officer when the prescribed officer requires the person to provide information about his or her undergoing the Specified Test;

<u>OR</u>

- (b) for a test at Community Testing Centres:-
 - attend one of the Community Testing Centres ^[Note 5] set up by the Government during its opening hours and undergo the Specified Test, including providing a sample, in accordance with the instructions given by the staff at the centre;
 - (ii) keep the SMS notification (mobile phone text message) containing the result of the test which must be issued within the past 14 days [Note 4] counting from the day when entering the Restricted Area or working at Terminal 1; and
 - (iii) provide the relevant SMS notification for checking by a prescribed officer when the prescribed officer requires the person to provide information about his or her undergoing the Specified Test;

OR

- (c) for a test with a specimen bottle obtained:-
 - (i) obtain a specimen bottle from one of the 121 post offices, 47 general out-patient clinics of the Hospital Authority or vending machines set up at 20 MTR stations [Note 7];
 - (ii) collect deep throat saliva sample in the specimen bottle as per the guidelines provided together with the specimen bottle and return the specimen bottle with the sample to one of the designated collection points ^[Note 7];
 - (iii) keep the SMS notification (mobile phone text message) containing the result of the test which must be issued within the past 14 days ^[Note 4] counting from the day when entering the Restricted Area or working at Terminal 1; and
 - (iv) provide the relevant SMS notification for checking by a prescribed officer when the prescribed officer requires the person to provide information about his or her undergoing the Specified Test;

<u>OR</u>

- (d) for a test using a specimen bottle distributed to the places mentioned in Part (I) above by the Department of Health (if applicable):—
 - (i) obtain a specimen bottle from the places mentioned in Part (I) above;

- (ii) collect relevant sample in the aforesaid specimen bottle as per the guidelines in the specimen collection pack and return the specimen bottle with the sample to one of the designated collection points ^[Note 7];
- (iii) keep the SMS notification (mobile phone text message) containing the result of the test which must be issued within the past 14 days ^[Note 4] counting from the day when entering the Restricted Area or working at Terminal 1; and
- (iv) provide the relevant SMS notification for checking by a prescribed officer when the prescribed officer requires the person to provide information about his or her undergoing the Specified Test;

<u>OR</u>

- (e) for a test at general out-patient clinics of the Hospital Authority:-
 - (i) undergo the Specified Test at general out-patient clinics of the Hospital Authority as instructed by a medical professional of the Hospital Authority;
 - (ii) keep the SMS notification (mobile phone text message) containing the result of the test which must be issued within the past 14 days ^[Note 4] counting from the day when entering the Restricted Area or working at Terminal 1; and
 - (iii) provide the relevant SMS notification for checking by a prescribed officer when the prescribed officer requires the person to provide information about his or her undergoing the Specified Test;

OR

- (f) for a self-arranged test:----
 - (i) arrange for the carrying out of the Specified Test at a laboratory which is included in a list of recognised laboratories for the Specified Test published at the coronavirus disease 2019 thematic website on https://www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/List_of_recognised_laboratories_RTPCR.pdf and which can issue SMS (mobile phone text message) notifications in respect of test results;
 - (ii) undergo the Specified Test in accordance with the instructions given by the staff of the laboratory;
 - (iii) keep the SMS notification (mobile phone text message) containing the result of the test which must be issued within the past 14 days [Note 4] counting from the day when entering the Restricted Area or working at Terminal 1; and
 - (iv) provide the relevant SMS notification for checking by a prescribed officer when the prescribed officer requires the person to provide information about his or her undergoing the Specified Test;

Period Specified for the Purpose of Section 14(3)(b) of the Regulation

(IV) specify in relation to the category of persons above the 30-day period from the day on which the person enters the Restricted Area or works at Terminal 1 as the period during which a Compulsory Testing Order may be issued under the Regulation upon non-compliance with this Notice;

Appointment of Prescribed Officers

(V) appoint members of the Auxiliary Medical Service and all public officers of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region to perform a function under the Regulation concerning a requirement specified under this Notice ^[Note 8].

This Notice comes into effect on 15 August 2021.

Note 1:--

For both the Sinovac COVID-19 vaccine (*CoronaVac vaccine*) and Fosun Pharma/ BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine (*Comirnaty vaccine*), completion of the vaccination course in general means having received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 days ago. For persons previously infected with COVID-19, they may be deemed to have completed the COVID-19 vaccination course after receiving one dose of Comirnaty vaccine or one dose of CoronaVac vaccine at least 14 days ago. For persons who received COVID-19 vaccines in places outside of Hong Kong and have received the recommended dose(s) as stipulated in relevant guidelines at least 14 days ago, they will also be regarded to have completed the vaccination course of the relevant COVID-19 vaccine, subject to the vaccine used being included on the list of vaccines recognised for specified purposes as published on https://www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/list_of_recognised_covid19_vaccines.pdf.

The 14th day before a person has completed a COVID-19 vaccination course is counted by taking the next day after the person received COVID-19 vaccine as the 1st day. For example, for a person who has not been infected with COVID-19 previously and who received the second dose of CoronaVac vaccine or Comirnaty vaccine on 31 July 2021, the "1st day" would be 1 August 2021 and the "14th day" would be 15 August 2021 on and after which the person would be considered to have completed a COVID-19 vaccination course.

Note 2:---

If the category of person specified in Part (I) is appointed or assigned by the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region to enter the Restricted Area for an emergency operation and stayed there for less than one hour, then the person is not required to comply with the requirements specified under this Notice.

If the category of person specified in Part (I) is appointed or assigned by the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region to enter the Restricted Area for an emergency operation and stayed there for more than one hour but could not provide the result of the Specified Test in accordance with the requirements and procedure as specified in Part (II) or (III) when entering the Restricted Area, then he/she is required to undergo the Specified Test in accordance with the requirements and procedure as specified in Part (II) or (III) (as applicable) within the 3-day period after entering the Restricted Area. The 3-day period after entering the Restricted Area is counted by taking the day of entering the Restricted Area as the 1st day. For example, if the relevant person enters the Restricted Area on 15 August 2021, he/she is required to undergo the Specified Test during the period from 15 August to 17 August 2021.

Note 3:—

The location, opening hours and target groups (if applicable) of the mobile specimen collection stations are set out in https://www.coronavirus.gov.hk/eng/early-testing.html.

Note 4:-

The past 7 days when entering the Restricted Area or Terminal 1 is counted by taking the day of entering the Restricted Area or Terminal 1 as the 7th day. The past 14 days when entering the Restricted Area or Terminal 1 is counted by taking the day of entering the Restricted Area or Terminal 1 as the 14th day. For example, if the relevant person enters the Restricted Area on 15 August 2021, the relevant "past 7 days" and "past 14 days" would be from 9 August to 15 August 2021 and from 2 August to 15 August 2021 respectively.

Note 5:—

Note 6:—

Having 'received the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine' means having received the first dose of Comirnaty vaccine or the first dose of CoronaVac vaccine, or having received, in places outside of Hong Kong, one dose of COVID-19 vaccine, subject to the vaccine used being included on the list of vaccines recognised for this purpose as published on the Government's COVID-19 Thematic Website (https://www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/list_of_recognised_covid19_vaccines.pdf).

Note 7:---

The location and opening hours of post offices, general out-patient clinics and MTR stations distributing specimen bottles as well as the specimen collection location and time are set out in https://www.coronavirus.gov.hk/eng/early-testing.html.

Note 8:---

Under the Regulation, health officers may, without the need of an appointment, perform a function concerning a requirement under a Compulsory Testing Notice.
