**United Nations Sanctions (Yemen) Regulation 2019
(Amendment) Regulation 2021**

(Made by the Chief Executive under section 3 of the United Nations Sanctions Ordinance (Cap. 537) on the instruction of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China and after consultation with the Executive Council)

1. United Nations Sanctions (Yemen) Regulation 2019 amended

The United Nations Sanctions (Yemen) Regulation 2019 (Cap. 537 sub. leg. CI) is amended as set out in sections 2 to 6.

2. Section 1 amended (interpretation)

“*Resolution 2564* (《第2564號決議》) means Resolution 2564 (2021) adopted by the Security Council on 25 February 2021;”.

3. Section 1A amended (limited duration of certain provisions)

After section 1A(3)—

“(4) Sections 5, 6 and 8 are in force during the period from the commencement of the United Nations Sanctions (Yemen) Regulation 2019 (Amendment) Regulation 2021 until midnight on 28 February 2022.”.

Explanatory Note

This Regulation amends the United Nations Sanctions (Yemen) Regulation 2019 (Cap. 537 sub. leg. CI) (*principal Regulation*) to give effect to certain decisions in Resolution 2564 (2021) adopted by the Security Council of the United Nations on 25 February 2021 (*Resolution 2564*).

2. Section 3 of this Regulation amends section 1A of the principal Regulation to provide that sections 5, 6 and 8 of the principal Regulation are in force until midnight on 28 February 2022.
3. Section 4 of this Regulation amends the definition of *specified person* in section 6(6) of the principal Regulation so that section 6 of the principal Regulation applies to the individual listed in the Annex to Resolution 2564.
4. Sections 5 and 6 of this Regulation amend sections 30(2) and 31(2) of the principal Regulation respectively so that the individual listed in the Annex to Resolution 2564 may be subject to sections 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the principal Regulation.
5. Sections 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of the principal Regulation relate to the prohibition against—
 - (a) the supply, sale, transfer or carriage of arms or related materiel to certain persons or entities;
 - (b) the provision of certain technical assistance, training or financial or other assistance to certain persons or entities;
 - (c) making available to, or for the benefit of, certain persons or entities any funds or other financial assets or economic resources;

- (d) dealing with funds or other financial assets or economic resources belonging to, or owned or controlled by, certain persons or entities; and
- (e) entry into or transit through the HKSAR by certain persons.
