ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN FO TAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 10 June 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Min Fong Street from its junction with Fo Tan Road to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Fo Tan Road from a point about 54 metres west with Min Fong Street to a point about 22 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of Fo Tan Road from a point about 40 metres west with Shan Mei Street to a point about 20 metres east of the same junction;
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Shan Mei Street from its junction with Fo Tan Road to a point about 84 metres south of the same junction;
- (e) the eastern kerbside lane of Shan Mei Street from its junction with Fo Tan Road to a point about 19 metres south of the same junction; and
- (f) the northern kerbside lane of access road leading from Fo Tan (Shan Mei Street) Bus Terminus to Shan Mei Street from its junction with Shan Mei Street to a point about 21 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
