ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI WAI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 25 November 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Fu Kin Street from a point about 43 metres west of its junction with Hin Hong Street to a point about 19 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Fu Kin Street from a point about 4 metres west of its junction with Hin Hong Street to a point about 41 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Hin Hong Street from its junction with Fu Kin Street to a point about 48 metres north of the same junction;
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Hin Hong Street from its junction with Fu Kin Street to a point about 18 metres north of the same junction;
- (e) the eastern kerbside lane of Hin Hong Street from its junction with Hin Tai Street to a point about 25 metres south of the same junction;
- (f) the western kerbside lane of Hin Hong Street from its junction with Hin Tai Street to a point about 43 metres south of the same junction;
- (g) the northern kerbside lane of Hin Tai Street from a point about 31 metres west of its junction with Hin Hong Street to a point about 13 metres east of the same junction; and
- (h) the southern kerbside lane of Hin Tai Street from a point about 17 metres west of its junction with Hin Hong Street to a point about 47 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
