## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

## RESTRICTED ZONES ON HOI YUEN ROAD AND HUNG TO ROAD, KWUN TONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 25 November 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Hoi Yuen Road from its junction with Hung To Road to a point about 80 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Hoi Yuen Road from its junction with Hung To Road to a point about 80 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of the roundabout between Wai Yip Street and Hoi Yuen Road from its junction with Hoi Yuen Road to a point about 35 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Hung To Road from its junction with Hoi Yuen Road to a point about 25 metres north of the same junction; and
- (e) the western kerbside lane of Hung To Road from its junction with Hoi Yuen Road to a point about 20 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
