TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, I have made an order under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358AL), to close temporarily or permanently the existing carriageway, footpaths, traffic islands and cycle tracks or parts thereof within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 261044/GZ/101 and 261044/GZ/102 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto. The Plans and scheme were referred to in G.N. 8144 published on 20 December 2019 and 27 December 2019. I have further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 358AL) that as from 17 February 2023, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the above existing carriageway, footpaths, traffic islands and cycle tracks or parts thereof to be permanently closed, shall be extinguished; and from 17 February 2023 to 16 February 2024, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the above existing carriageway, footpaths, traffic islands and cycle tracks or parts thereof to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished; and from 17 February 2023 to 16 February 2024, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the above existing carriageway, footpaths, traffic islands and cycle tracks or parts thereof.

The sewerage works to be carried out on the above affected existing carriageways, footpaths, traffic islands and cycle tracks mainly involve:—

- (i) Construction of a sewage pumping station, about 950 metres of gravity sewers and associated manholes, and about 205 metres of twin sewage rising mains within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans; and
- (ii) Ancillary works including reinstatement of affected carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks and traffic islands.

A copy of the order and the Plans showing the above affected existing carriageways, footpaths, traffic islands and cycle tracks may be inspected by members of the public, free of charge, at the following locations and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—
