ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 sub. leg. G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON TSING YI ROAD, TSING YI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 17 March 2023, the following road sections on Tsing Yi Road will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Tsing Yi Road from a point about 5 metres north of its junction with Sai Shan Road to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Tsing Yi Road from a point about 5 metres south of its junction with Sai Shan Road to a point about 233 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Tsing Yi Road from a point about 13 metres north of its junction with Sai Shan Road to a point about 38 metres north of the same junction;
- (d) the eastern kerbside lane of Tsing Yi Road from a point about 156 metres south of its junction with Sai Shan Road to a point about 188 metres south of the same junction; and
- (e) the eastern kerbside lane of Tsing Yi Road from a point about 205 metres south of its junction with Sai Shan Road to a point about 233 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
