ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON KAI TIN ROAD, LAM TIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 24 March 2023, the following road sections in Lam Tin will be designated as restricted zones from 7.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside of Kai Tin Road from a point about 145 metres south of its junction with Tak Tin Street to a point about 200 metres south of the same junction; and
- (b) the eastern kerbside of Kai Tin Road from a point about 200 metres south of its junction with Tak Tin Street to a point about 260 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones of item (a) above, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses, public light buses, taxis and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

Within the restricted zones of item (b) above, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses, taxis and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs or road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
