ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 sub. leg. G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON SHA TAU KOK ROAD—WO HANG, NORTH DISTRICT

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 27 March 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Sha Tau Kok Road—Wo Hang from a point about 10 metres east of its junction with the unnamed access road leading to Au Ha Tsuen to a point about 40 metres east of the same junction; and
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Sha Tau Kok Road—Wo Hang from a point about 25 metres east of its junction with the unnamed access road leading to Au Ha Tsuen to a point about 50 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
