ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON CASTLE PEAK ROAD—KWU TUNG, SHEUNG SHUI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 24 March 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Castle Peak Road—Kwu Tung from a point about 260 metres west of its junction with Fan Kam Road (near North District Hospital) to a point about 380 metres west of the same junction; and
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Castle Peak Road—Kwu Tung from a point about 400 metres west of its junction with Fan Kam Road (near North District Hospital) to a point about 300 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
