

ESTATE AGENTS ORDINANCE (Chapter 511)

Pursuant to section 30 of the Estate Agents Ordinance, it is hereby notified that the Disciplinary Committee of Estate Agents Authority has exercised the following disciplinary power against the following licensee:—

<i>Matter Concerned</i>	The licensee:— (i) arranged for the transacting party to sign a provisional agreement for sale and purchase with certain essential terms left blank; and (ii) (Same as above).
<i>Date of Decision</i>	14 February 2023
<i>Decision on Disciplinary Power Exercised</i>	1. In respect of the aforesaid matter (i):— (a) The licensee is reprimanded; and (b) A condition is attached to the licensee's licence requiring the licensee to attend and complete activities under the Estate Agents Authority Continuing Professional Development Scheme 'Compliance and Effective Management' category by way of seminars or lectures only and thereby acquire 12 points recognised by the Estate Agents Authority within 12 months. 2. In respect of the aforesaid matter (ii):— (a) The licensee is reprimanded; and (b) A condition is attached to the licensee's licence requiring the licensee to attend and complete activities under the Estate Agents Authority Continuing Professional Development Scheme 'Compliance and Effective Management' category by way of seminars or lectures only and thereby acquire 12 points recognised by the Estate Agents Authority within 12 months.

With regard to paragraphs 1(b) and 2(b) above, the condition being attached to the licence concerned of the licensee is as follows:—

'The above-named licensee shall, during the period of 24 months from 6 March 2023 to 5 March 2025, attend and complete activities under the Estate Agents Authority Continuing Professional Development Scheme 'Compliance and Effective Management' category by way of seminars or lectures only and thereby acquire 24 points recognised by the Estate Agents Authority.'
