Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection proposes to execute the sewerage works within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 178711/B/ENG/11016 to 11022 and Resumption Plan No. ISM3420 (Sheet 1 to 3) (the 'Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plans and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed sewerage works is as follows:-

- (i) construction of about 900 metres of gravity sewers and associated manholes along Cheung Fu Street and adjacent to South Lantau Road within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans:
- (ii) construction of 3 sewage pumping stations at Cheung Fu Street, Cheung Sha and San Shek Wan and the associated about 400 metres of twin rising mains and chambers within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans;
- (iii) construction of about 3 700 metres of gravity sewers and associated manholes in San Wai and Lo Wai at Pui O within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans; and
- (iv) ancillary works including temporary closure and reinstatement of carriageways, footpaths and open space or parts thereof.

Objectors are required to provide contact details to the Director to facilitate communication.
