ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES AT KWONG SIN STREET AND HANG SHIN LINK, SHA TIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 31 March 2023, the following sections of Kwong Sin Street and Hang Shin Link will be designated as restricted zones at the periods as specified below:—

From 7.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight daily

- (a) the section of Kwong Sin Street northbound from a point about 35 metres north of its junction with Hang Shin Link to a point about 110 metres north of the same junction; and
- (b) the section of Kwong Sin Street southbound from a point about 160 metres north of its junction with Hang Shin Link to a point about 85 metres north of the same junction.

24 hours daily

- (a) the section of Kwong Sin Street northbound from a point about 20 metres south of its junction with Hang Shin Link to a point about 35 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the section of Kwong Sin Street southbound from a point about 85 metres north of its junction with Hang Shin Link to the same junction; and
- (c) the section of Hang Shin Link southbound from its junction with Kwong Sin Street to a point about 10 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
